



**All Nydree Engineered Flooring Products  
Formaldehyde Testing  
CARB Phase 2 Plywood Platform**

Nydree is considered a fabricator of laminated product (not a manufacturer of plywood) and is not required to routinely test plywood for formaldehyde levels per the California Air Resources Board (CARB) regulations. Nevertheless, out of an abundance of caution, we want to make sure our plywood suppliers are consistently providing CARB Phase 2 plywood. This is important to Nydree because CARB emissions requirements have officially been adopted nationwide with the implementation of the EPA TSCA Title VI Formaldehyde Emission Standard for Composite Wood Products.

Nydree recently had samples from our current plywood supplier and resulting flooring tested for formaldehyde Emissions at a third-party laboratory.

Both the plywood and flooring (finished faces exposed) received a result of BLQ which means "below limit of quantitation." The lab's limit of quantitation is 0.008 ppm, so the samples submitted registered below 0.008 ppm.

The flooring (unfinished backs exposed) received a result of 0.02 ppm, which is lower than the CARB Phase 2 limit of 0.05 ppm for Hardwood Plywood.
